

## Quiz Answers

- 1.a) Models contacted cannot make free strikes against the trampling model. Prime, page 56.
- 2.c) Models with Combined Melee Attack can always combine their melee attacks, regardless of the nature of weapons or charge/non-charge attacks. They however lose the charge bonus if a charge attack is combined with a non-charge attack. Prime, page 62.
- 3.d) In a two-handed throw, the distance is determined and measured according to "Being Thrown" on p.54 of Prime, just as a regular throw.
- 4.b) In MkII, frenzy only lasts the activation of the warbeast (Primal p. 74). You can transfer and use its animus as usual, but you cannot rile it since it needs to activate.
- 5.b) Gunfighter doesn't alleviate the ban from doing melee attacks and ranged attacks in the same activation. Prime, p. 63.
- 6.a) A model your opponent is taking control of becomes an enemy model. Prime, p. 28.
- 7.d) In MkII, models have a back arc while knocked down (Prime, p. 63). Spellbreaker dispels upkeep on a hit.
- 8.c) As per the Activation Timing (Prime p. 244). Greygore has forfeited his movement or action and cannot charge, however.

- 13.b) As its name implies, the "Fraternal" Order accepts only male wizards. See e.g. IKCG, p. 224.

- 16.b) Every Trollkin sorcerer is an albino. See e.g. MN1, p. 237.

- 19.a) Every Nyss warrior and cleric is given a runed-engraved claymore during a special ceremony. See e.g. IKCG, p. 53.
